INVITATION FOR SCOUTS AGED 12 –
18 YRS AND LEADERS. 11 – 18
DECEMBER 2002 – RIDERS RANCH,
SIDVOKODVO, MANZINI.**

The Swaziland Boy Scouts Association kindly sends its warmest invitation to the 2nd Swaziland National Jamboree.

DATE: 11 December 2002 to 18 December 2002

THEME: Scouts delivery

VENUE: Riders Ranch, Sidvokodvo along Manzini/ Nhlanguano road, 20km from the Matsapha airport and 15minutes drive from Manzini City Centre.

ATTENDANCE:

2500 Scouts and leaders from all over the country including 450 Scouts/Guides from Swaziland and leaders from other countries.

Scouts/Guides and leaders must be registered members of their own National Scout/Guides organizations and their application must be approved by their National Scouts/Guides Organizations.

ELIGIBILITY:

The 2nd Swaziland National Jamboree Programs are designed for male/female Scouts/Guides age between 11 – 18 years. Scouts/Senior Scout can take part.

However, international scouts/Guides aged 18 – 21 years are also welcome to challenge the Jamboree programmes.

JAMBOREE FEE:

The Jamboree fee is US \$ 150 per person, which covers food, Jamboree scarf, Jamboree badge and Jamboree tours.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 11 December Wednesday – camp site open - arrival
- 12 December Thursday – official opening ceremony/on site activities
- 13 December Friday - onsite/off site activities
- 14 December Saturday – off site activities/tours
- 15 December Sunday return from offsite activity/tours
- December Sunday scout own @ evening
- 16 December Monday – Africa day/off & onsite activities
- 17 December Tuesday – other region/onsite & offsite activities
- 18 December Wednesday – official closing/department.

CLIMATE AT THE JAMBOREE:

Average temperature at the Jamboree site on the beginning of December in the past 3 years has been 29.6C (the minimum 26.1 C and the Maximum 32.5C). The average rainfall is 3.1mm per day during December.
